

In our OneMart and Shopsy you are able to use the "Our Team" widget to showcase your team.

This is not a standard widget and requires the HTML code to be modified to make changes.


Create or open a new page in the site builder and add the widget called "Our Team". If you already have it loaded on a page the following applies along with adding it for the first time.

You can edit this area of the widget without going into the HTML code. This is the default text that is part of the widget.

Each section as shown here represents one person. So, if you want to remove or add the amount of people remove or add these sections.

**After making these changes make sure to save, preview and publish.**

To manage images in RepDesk you will need to create a new vendor, add items, and then assign the items the images you wish to use.

1. Create a vendor called something like Our Team.
2. Create new items in that vendor called the team member's name.
3. Go into image management and select local storage for that vendor.
4. Add the images that you wish to use and hit next.
5. Drag the images to the member's name.
6. Go back to the item you created for that new vendor and click on the item to open it up.
7. Click on the full image link.
8. Copy and use that URL as the image for the member.
