

How to tokenize payment information in RepDesk

This documentation will provide the steps necessary for tokenizing a customer's payment information in RepDesk.

1. First, find an existing sales order, or make a new one if there are no existing orders, with the customer and vendor you would like to tokenize. Select the vendor in that sales order.

2. Next, you will have to edit and update the card that you would like to tokenize. To do this, please select the edit icon and add the CC information and then select "Update Customer file" on the bottom of the section. Please note that the credit card information such as the address, zip code, name, etc., must match the card holder's information.

3. You will be able to tell if the tokenization was successful by not being able to edit the fields in the credit card section. The address, city, state, CVV, etc., fields will be "greyed out" and will not be editable. Please see example below
